

Post Doc Fellowship – CANCER BIOLOGY (ref: ADMC14/06)

ADMC and the Medical Research Council Toxicology Unit, a leading research centre for cell death and mechanisms in tissue injury, invites applications from highly motivated postdoctoral scientists to join the Cancer Biology Group led by **Gerry MELINO** to work on projects focusing on cancer and cell death with a particular interest in the role of the p53 family in tumourigenesis, metastasis and chemo-resistance. This is a one year (extendible up to three years) training and development position for a scientist who has completed their PhD or who wishes to move into a new research discipline. Candidates should have a background and interest in cell death, the p53 family and/or DNA damage and/or micro-RNA.

The starting salary will be in the region of €30,000 (equivalent to circa £25,000) per annum.
